



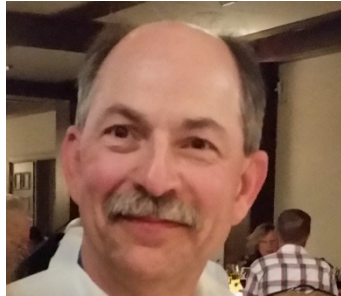

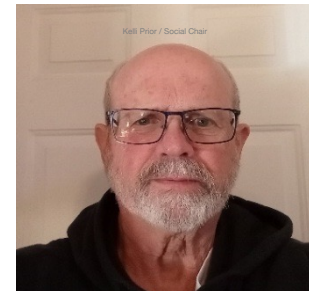

# Porsche Club of America Structure

- National is comprised of 148 regions (local chapters) in the USA and Canada. Total Membership 172K+
- Regions are grouped into 14 geographical zones
- Zone 1 is the largest in geographic area and membership total (27,642 total members as of 3/28/26)
- Zone 1 has 17 Regions or 16 % of the PCA membership base
- Finger Lakes Region is in Zone 1
- Finger Lakes Region total membership is 240
- Fun Fact: Watkins Glen International Race Track is in the Finger Lakes Region boundary



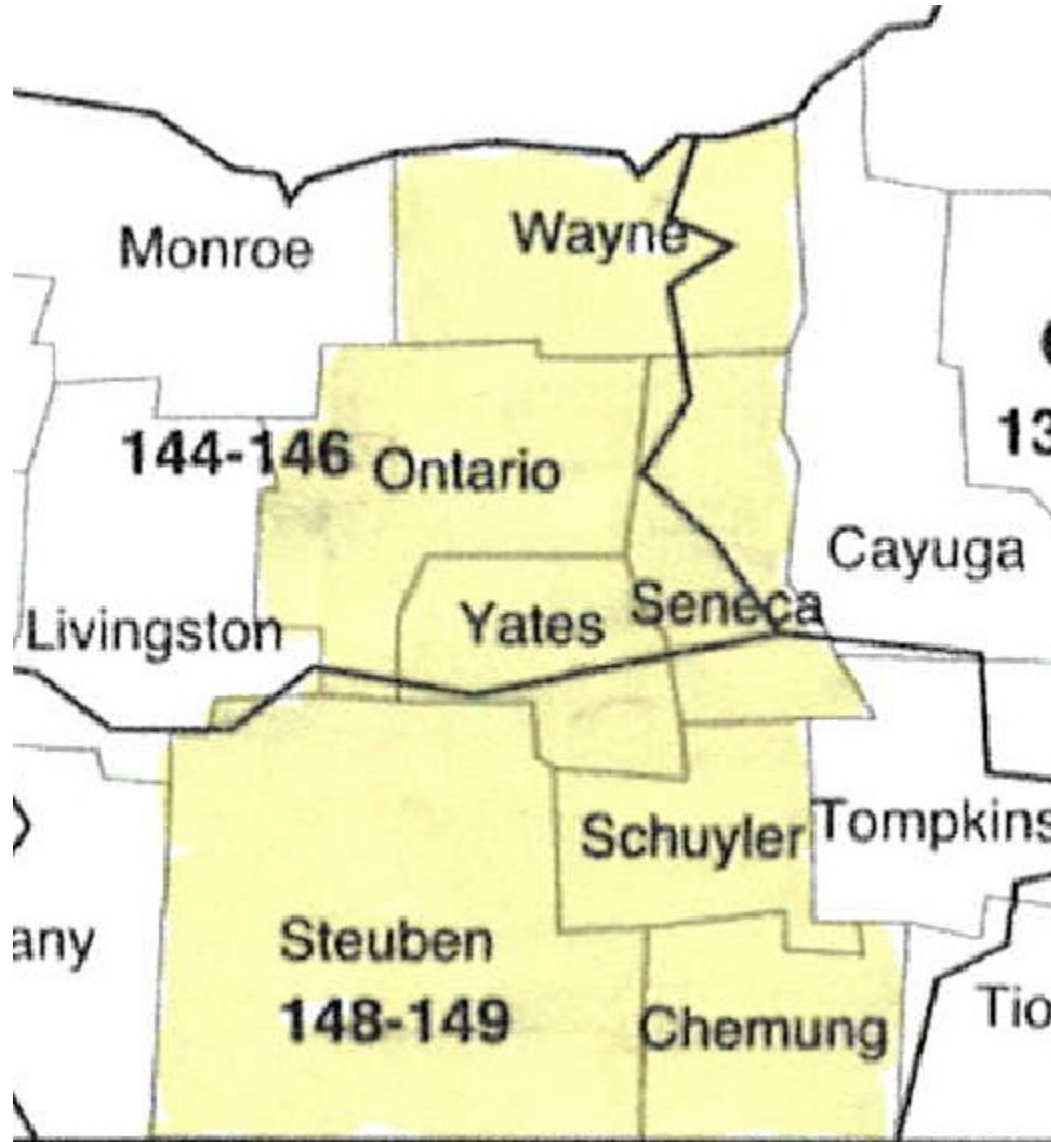
## ZONE'S ROLE IN PCA STRUCTURE

- Zones were created in 1969 to better support regions
- Reps are liaison between National and Local Regions
- Reps are chosen who have broad PCA experience/skills
- Reps meet with National Executive Council 1x a month
- Information is then communicated to the Region Presidents
  - National and special programs
  - Events
  - Communicate and clarify National issues/discussions/policies
- Region Presidents rely on Rep to keep them informed and to answer questions they have
- Rep also represents region issues/points of view to National



# FINGER LAKES REGION

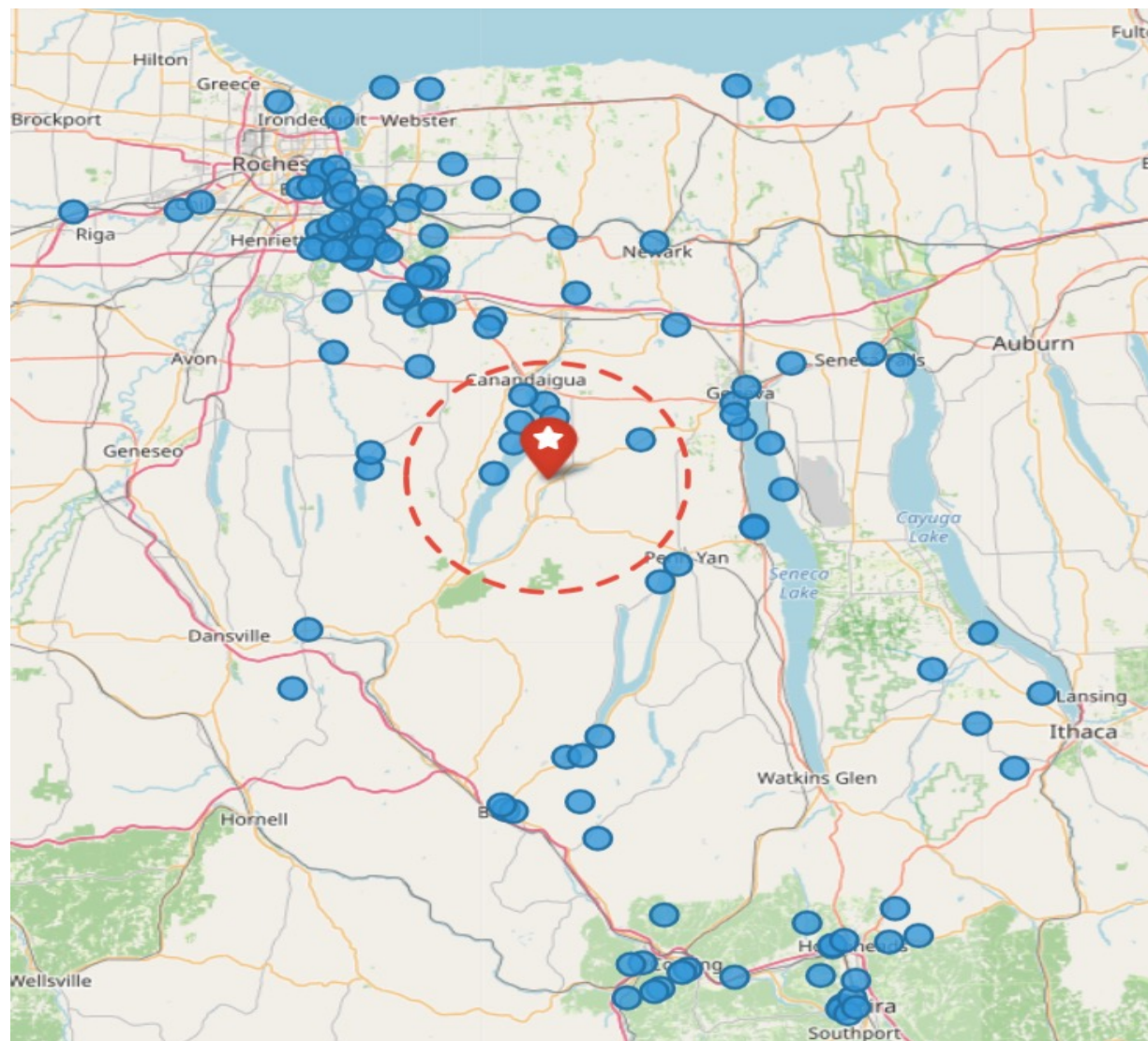
- The 7 highlighted counties make up the Finger Lakes Region

## FINGER LAKES REGION PORSCHE CLUB OF AMERICA Treasurer's Report Full Year Ending December 31, 2025

Below is a summary of our activity January 1, 2025 – December 31, 2025.

Our cash balance per book at the end of December 2024 was **\$6,856.13**.

During the period from January 1, 2025 to December 31, 2025, we had cash receipts of **\$16,172.96** and cash disbursements of **\$7,153.69**.

Therefore, there were Receipts in excess of Disbursements of **\$9,019.27** for the period January 1, 2025 through December 31, 2025.

# Charity Highlights

- The region has been giving money to worthy causes consistently since 2020
- A few years ago, the FLK Board decided to give focus to this opportunity by adding a Charity Chair position to the Board
- At that time, the Board also decided to be intentional on 3 aspects of giving:
  - The types of organizations we give to (food insecurity, housing challenges, children's services, and transportation museums)
  - Balancing our giving across the 7 counties in our region (Wayne, Ontario, Seneca, Steuben, Schuyler, Yates, Chemung), with consideration for Monroe County as well
  - Consistency – the yearly target is about 10 % of our available funds (which we have been meeting)
- Recent giving includes Habitat for Humanity (3 counties), Food Bank of the Southern Tier, Happiness House, Camp Stella Maris, NY Penn Pathways (Girl Scouts), Highland Hospital, and the International Motor Racing Research Center
- Some years we also do fundraising from members to supplement region giving (e.g. Girl Scouts in 2025)
